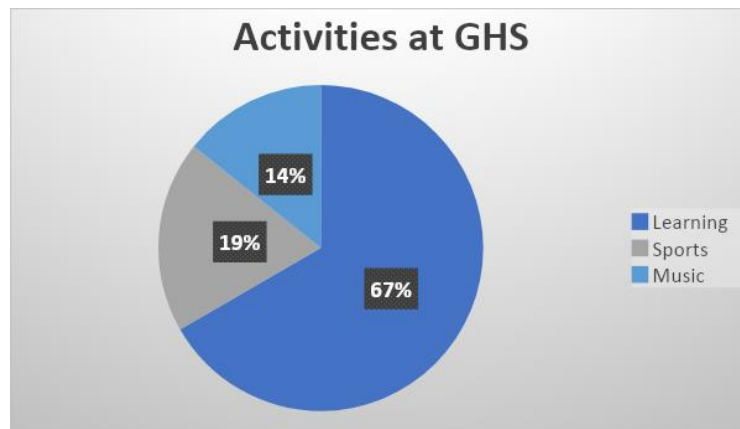
Dear future year 7 students,
