Revision Strategies for Year 11

With the first round of mock exams completed. It is time to look ahead to strategies that can be used to continue to support students at home. One of the main areas of focus is on retaining knowledge. Below are some strategies that can be used to support:

- Creating a flash card for each key word. Writing the key word on one side and the definition on the other. This can also be completed electronically on Quizlet.
- Using key terms list provided by subjects. Cover the explanation and see what you can remember.
- Dumping activity. Use a blank page to get down all of the information you can remember and then use a different coloured pen to add in what you did not remember. Keep repeating this process until you remember more information


