ITEM	CLARIFICATION
 Blazer Black with embroidered GHS badge. 	 <u>Compulsory</u> – it is to be always worn, unless given permission by a teacher. No fitted style blazers are allowed. KS3 – Green lapels. KS4 – Purple lapels. Students may ask their teacher if they wish to remove their blazer in lessons, especially in warm conditions. In <u>warm</u> conditions <u>or</u> a <u>heat</u> <u>wave</u>, students must have to wear a blazer but must have it with them. Students must always wear a tie, including at break and lunchtimes. Students are not allowed to wear PE kit to school during warm conditions <u>or</u> a heat wave.
Tie • KS3 – Green with stripes. • KS4 – Purple with stripes. • JLT – Black with purple & green stripes.	 <u>Compulsory</u> – Must be worn, always.
 Shirt Plain white, long, or short sleeves. Collars must be designed to accommodate a tie and have a top button that fastens. 	 Shirts must be sufficiently generous to tuck into the skirt or trousers. No tailored shirts which are designed to be worn over skirts/trousers. Top buttons must be done up.
 Trousers Black school trousers. Sufficiently tailored to keep the shirt tucked in and so that underwear is not visible. 	 Trousers must sit on the waist, be full length and cover the ankles. Trousers are not allowed to be skin-tight and must have a natural hang. Underwear must be always covered. A plain black belt may be worn.
 Skirt Black A-line or pleated school skirt to the knee length 	 Skirt must be no higher than the knee and should not be skin- tight. Skirts must not be worn on the hip <u>or</u> rolled up.

 Black v neck jumper. 	 The jumper is optional; it <u>cannot</u> <u>be worn in place of a blazer</u>. Cardigans and tank tops are not to be worn. Hoodies are not allowed.
• Students are allowed to wear an outer jacket over their blazer, especially during the winter months.	 Should be formal and designed to be worn over a suit/blazer. No sports/tracksuit style jackets/tops will be allowed.
 <u>Socks/Tights</u> White or black socks. Plain black tights. <u>Shoes</u> Black (upper and sole). Smart, plain, and polishable. 	 No leg warmers. No above the knee socks. No coloured socks of any kind. Socks or tights should be worn, not both. Trainer style shoes (even if leather) or canvas style footwear are not appropriate as formal school footwear. Boots are not allowed.
 <u>School scarf</u> School scarf or plain black, white, purple, or green. No patterned scarves are allowed. 	 Baseball caps are not permitted. Scarves and hats should be put in your bag or locker except during break and lunch (unless worn for religious reasons).
 Hair bands, ribbons, clips, and any other item used in the hair should be plain black, white, purple, <u>or</u> green. 	 No flowers, frills, <u>or</u> large bows. No Bandanas <u>or</u> overly large hair bands are not allowed. Dyed hair is not allowed. Students must have natural coloured hair. No shaved designs <u>or</u> lines are allowed in hair <u>or</u> eyebrows.
 <u>Jewellery</u> <u>One</u> small single gold <u>or</u> silver stud earrings may be worn in each ear lobe. Rings, necklaces, bracelets should not be worn. A small neutral nose stud can be worn. <u>A hoop will not be</u> <u>acceptable.</u> 	 No other piercing is acceptable e.g., cartilage of ear, eyebrow, <u>or</u> tongue. Excuses like "they cannot be taken out because they have only just been done" will not be <u>accepted</u> and students will be <u>instructed to remove them</u>. Items of religious symbolism should be worn under the school uniform.
Make up and Nail Varnish	 Students will be asked to remove it.

 Must not be worn. 	 No false nails <u>or</u> extensions. No eyelash extensions to be worn
<u>Badges</u>	 No badges <u>or</u> political symbols <u>or</u> flags to be displayed. Only official school badges to be worn on school uniform.

- School uniform must be worn correctly on the way **to and from school**, (including before /after PE lessons)
- If students arrive at school wearing incorrect uniforms, they will be **loaned uniforms** via **student services** and **must** wear this throughout the day.
- Students who fail to comply by our uniform policy will be sanctioned with a 30-minute detention <u>or</u> 60-minute detention if the concerns are persistent. Items will be <u>confiscated</u>. Confiscated items will need to be collected from school by a parent <u>or</u> carer.
- If you are in doubt about uniforms, then the likelihood is that it is wrong. Please do not risk buying your child an item which is incorrect if they say, "**everyone's** got them".
