

Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to firstly welcome myself, Mr Mahay, as Head of Year 8 at Greenford High School. It has been a pleasure working with many parent/carers and students over the first half term and I look forward to continuing with this over this academic year. Year 8 is a crucial year at Greenford as student move over from i-Block onto main site and become part of our wider school community. It is vial for our student to remember the **basics** around school life and expectations.

There has been a huge focus on our basics as once these are secured, it aids our pupils to focus on the more important aspects of school life. It also resembles how our pupils are proud Greenford students and the idea of uniformity, where everyone has equal opportunity.

Our school basics include:

- Attendance All pupils should aim to have <u>100%</u> attendance. We understand that as the weather changes, coughs and colds become more common however, if your child is well enough to be in school please send them in. Their **resilience** and **courage** are hugely commended!
- Punctuality A reminder that the main gate closes at 08:32am and students are expected to be in their form classes or 08:35. Ay students who arrive after this will be marked as late with a 30-minute afterschool detention on the day. In addition to this, any students late past the second bell to periods 1,3 or 5 will serve a 15-minute lunch detention (the following days lunch for period 5).
- Uniform We thank you immensely for your efforts in ensuring your child looks the part when attending Greenford High School. A reminder that all students should have the correct uniform. This includes *blazers*, *school shoes* and *ties*.

With the cold weather creeping up on us, students should have a warm jacket/coat to wear. <u>Scarfs should be plain in colour</u> and <u>fluffy socks are not to be worn</u>.

• No political statements or signs – As a school we appreciate the diverse range of ethic backgrounds our students belong to. It is crucial we respect all backgrounds and therefore no student should be brining in any badges, flags, or representation which could upset our school community.

We also have the **KS3 Study Space** accessible to all KS3 students which is open **Monday-Thursday** from **3:10 – 4:10** in **CG13** where students can go to and complete their work in the presence of staff members and post-16 helpers.
