Our first round of mock exams begins on <u>Monday</u> <u>6th November</u> and these will be on our EBACC subjects: Maths, English, Science and Modern Foreign Languages (Spanish, French and German.) We then have our second round of mocks in all subjects, starting on <u>Monday 4th December</u>. Your child will shortly receive their bespoke exams timetable. In tutor time, your child will create a revision timetable and discuss the best revision techniques. Please ensure these are used by your child over the half-term.

### Studio 11 and intervention:

This is a group of 40 students, who have been specially selected to engage in lecture style revision sessions with the Deputy Heads of Maths and English to support students achieving grades 5 in their GCSEs.
