Technical & Further Education Act (Baker Clause)

Introduction

This policy statement sets out Greenford High School's commitment to providing our pupils with a comprehensive understanding of the full range of educational opportunities available to them. This includes technical education and apprenticeship options and is in compliance with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Pupil Entitlement

Students in Years 8-13 are entitled to:

- Hear from a range of local education and training providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education qualifications and apprenticeships – through events such as careers fairs, assemblies and information sessions.
- Find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships at each transition point to ensure pupils understand the breadth of opportunities available.
- Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Opportunities for Access

A number of events scheduled in the school calendar will provide an opportunity for providers to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers where they can engage directly with our school community or via information provided through newsletters and the school website.
