# **Technical & Further Education Act (Baker Clause)**

**January 2019**

**Introduction**

This policy statement sets out Greenford High School's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education and/or training offer.

This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

### **Pupil Entitlement**

Students in years 8-13 are entitled to:

- Hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through events such as Careers Fairs
- Find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships at each transition point.
- Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

### **Opportunities for Access**

A number of events scheduled in the school calendar will provide an opportunity for providers to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers
